Check the Sender:

Look for misspelled email addresses or strange domains.
Example: Real email: info@example.com / Phishing email: info@examp1e.com



Watch for Urgency:

Beware of emails that demand immediate action or threaten consequences.
Red Flags: "Your account will be locked"



Be Cautious with Links and Attachments:

Hover over links to see the actual website before clicking.
Avoid opening unexpected attachments that could contain harmful software.

Tips to Stay Safe:

Think Before You Click: Take a moment to think before interacting with suspicious emails.

Verify the Sender: Confirm the identity of the sender if you're unsure about an email.

Stay Informed: Keep up-to-date on common phishing tactics and security best practices.
